How to use

 To start using the Nokia Internet Modem once installed, insert the modem into a USB port, double click on the desktop icon. Wait for the software to initialise and detect a network. The detected network will display below the options menu button. The LED light on the modem should also blink blue or green depending on the type of network.



 To connect, click the connect button and wait for confirmation that the connection has been successful.



To Disconnect click Disconnect either from the Nokia Internet Modem dashboard or from the dialog below.

CS-10 Installation

- 1. Insert USB modem in to a spare USB port on your computer, which meets the compatibility requirements.
- 2. Wait for modem to self install its drivers, and wait for dialog box to prompt for installation language. Choose your preferred language.



3. If the following message appears, ignore it by clicking OK.



4. The Nokia Internet Modem installation wizard should appear. Continue through the wizard by clicking Next on each screen to continue. Accept the License Agreement when prompted and then accept the default installation location. Click Install to start the installation.





5. Wait for the installation to complete, and click finish once prompted.



- 6. If prompted, restart your laptop with the modem still plugged in.
- 7. Once completed, a new icon will appear both on the desktop and in the system tray (bottom right hand corner)



Setting Up

- Initially it is important to go through a quick setup procedure, to ensure your Nokia Internet Modem is using the correct settings to connect to the internet.
- Launch the Nokia software by plugging in the modem and double clicking on the Nokia Internet Modem icon on the desktop.
- 3. From the menu bar, select **Options > Settings > Connections (Dial-up) > New > Create a new connection > Next >**

Enter the information located on the cover of these instructions in each field:

- Connection name: Access Point Name: User Name: Password:
- Domain: (leave this blank)
- Click Finish

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You will be returned to the list of all connection profiles. Select the newly created profile, named (on cover), and click the 'Default' button. A check mark will appear next to network connection to show it is now the default connection.

- 5. Click OK. It should now be possible to click connect and connect to the internet.
- For future use you will only need to follow the How to Use instructions. The connection profile should be saved for all future connection attempts.
